**Have you noticed?** We have had several maintenance items completed over the last few months. New pads were installed on the kneelers, some rotten wood was replaced on some of our windows, a new screen door was installed on the rectory porch with new wood around it, the Plexiglass protecting our windows was polished or replaced, and finally, the windows were sanded, painted, and re-caulked. We are planning to replace the plexiglass covering the statue in the alcove of the steeple next spring. The steeple trim also needs painted but will be costly due to the height. A special lift will need to be rented.

**Eucharist** "makes present the one sacrifice of Christ the Savior." (CCC, no 1330) In the celebration of the Eucharist, bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit and the instrumentality of the priest.
