- **16% of the Diocesan Budget** goes toward Support for Youth & Young Adults- our Newman Centers, Higher Ground, Totus Tuus, Steubenville, Teens Encounter Christ, and March for Life.
- **10% of the Diocesan Budget** includes other ministries (Pro-Life, West Nebraska Catholic, CEC, and Community Mental Health).
